WINNER RESIDENTIAL - RENOVATION UNDER 3500

Sensitivity to the ranch environment created a house with unusual character using recycled materials. Moving an old cabin with good bones, i.e. flooring, pine walls, old rafters and referring to the style of “continuous architecture” that was done at the turn of the century on many old farms and ranches. Space planning concept was to surround the original cabin with the additions.

Silo was renovated and attached to main area along with porch, back entry, mudroom/laundry, master suite and bath, guest bath, private guest suite and two guest bedrooms.

Original ceilings and floors remained intact. Walls, floors and ceilings were scraped to lighten color palette. Kitchen ceiling remained original turquoise color. Interior doors and barn doors were fabricated from original exterior siding and whitewashed.

Comfortable furniture with primitive antique pieces, antique rugs and much saturated color finished this contemporary farm house.
